RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1 The competition is open to everyone from school years 3 and no limit to age above this.
- 2 Participants must reside in the Parish of Fair Oak and Horton Heath.
- 3 There will be two representatives chosen to act as the Parish Council's Ambassadors on Carnival Day.
- 4 Applicants must be available to take part on Carnival day, Saturday 29 June 2019.
- 5 The Carnival court will be expected to collect money along the carnival route.
- 6 The Carnival Court will be expected to present the carnival entrants with their prizes at New Century Park following the procession.
- 7 The Parish Council will allocate up to £50 towards an outfit and shoes. Receipts must be kept and handed into the Parish Council offices. Outfits may be chosen by the winners and must be appropriate to a Carnival Court.
- 8 The Parish Council will provide a sash and tiara/crown which must be worn. These to be returned to the Parish Council office after the event.
- 9 Judging will be by the Community Events Sub-Committee and their decision is final. You will be informed if you have been successful.
- 10 All forms must be signed by a parent or guardian, if applicant is 16 or under.
- 11 Entrants must agree to allow photos to be published in the Parish Council newsletter, on the website, facebook and at the sponsors, Kutis Noraani Indian restaurant.
- 12 If aged 16 or under parents/guardians must take responsibility at all times for their children during the above mentioned activities.
